MEETING MINUTES FEBRUARY 29, 2016

Copies of the Dansereau and Wright abatements were left for the tax collector.

Wally Roney met with the secretary this past week and followed up with Bruce Smith.

The selectmen signed the letter to Barbara Patnode about having Graz Engineering monitor and bill them for their progress on their subdivision road.

The Town of Surry has requested Avitar to supply another assessor while our regular one is out on leave. The selectmen discussed the LUCT for the Patnodes .

The selectmen researched the RSA for posting weight limits on town roads and concluded there was no actual official starting date.

Jay Croteau spoke with Durwin Clark about having the state repair their portion of the Old Walpole Rd.

Jay Croteau motioned to accept the minutes. Eric Eichner seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes as presented.

Bruce Smith has been looking through the existing maps in the office to find any old cemetery maps that may be helpful in establishing a foundation for the trustees to work from. The selectmen worked on purging the old maps.

The selectmen signed the PA 29 for Devin Plaskiewicz for military exemption. Jay Croteau returned the letter as approved.

Durwin Clark reported there was minimum damage to the roads from the last storm.

Eric Eichner motioned to adjourn. Jay Croteau seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.
