Jay Croteau let Bob Bergervin know that the selectmen would not authorize the use of the Gerow Fund for the tree removal in the North cemetery. There may be other cemetery funds which could be used for general upkeep.

Bruce Smith is working on the 2020 Census. The return letter was signed by Eric Eichner as chair.

Bruce Smith motioned to accept the mintutes. Jay Croteau seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes.

The pictures of the Joslin Road bridge abutments were sent to the DES.

Jodi Leach will not be able to work on the sexton's shed .

Bruce Smith asked for the billing information from Avitar for the trustees to refund the general fund.

Josh Brooks spoke extensively to the selectmen about the fire station addition he is proposing. Lawrence Consulting has been working on the addition plans and the compliance issues.
