MEETING MINUTES JUNE 1, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Bruce Smith and Eric Eichner.

The Town of Surry issued building permit # 1042 to Jason Smart for a dormer on his home at 613 Old Walpole Road Surry. The Town of Surry received check #447 in the amount of \$12.00 for the permit.

The selectmen signed the letter to Mr. Sargent answering his question on disability exemption.

The elderly exemption qualifications were sent to Freeman Rivers of 12 Bear Den Road.

The selectmen signed the letter to Brian Hanson and Leah Garrapy explaining in order to run a day care they would need to have a special exception from the zoning board.

Bruce Smith has referred the Army Corp of Engineers questions on the Pond Road to Graz Engineering and wetlands specialist Jonathan Sisson.

The selectmen discussed Durwin Clarks' upcoming performance review. Copies of his prior years review were added to his file.

The selectmen signed the payroll requests.

Bruce Smith looked at the area in question for Mrs. Larocca's complaints about visibility on the Joslin Road and found them to be unsubstantiated. He felt the visibility was not hindered enough to address. He also stated the erosion area in question should be planted with grass seed for stability. Jay Croteau stated Durwin Clark had fixed the hole in the road.
