MEETING MINUTES DECEMBER 14, 2015

The culverts on the Mine Ledge Road were completed, the embankment stabilized and seeded, the road extension was filled out and the ditches were cleaned out. The road may need another load of gravel.

Steve Goldsmith dropped off his building inspectors bill and an estimate from Williams Construction Group for the town hall addition.

John Davis signed the Intent to Cut for the Quintillio logging operation.

The air leak on the dump truck has been repaired.

Jay Croteau updated the culvert map with the new culvert replacements.

Jay Croteau worked on the letters for the Pond Road culvert estimates.

The City of Keene has estimated \$21,975.53 for the ambulance stand by fee for 2016 for the Budget Committee.

Jeff Morel checked the battery on the defibrillator. He will be standing in as the deputy emergency coordinator and has offered to teach any of the safety subjects he is qualified to teach to Surry employees and volunteer fire fighters.

Jeff Morel requested an updated Pistol Permit.
