He would like to see an addition onto the fire station for the vehicle especially when the brush truck is back at the station.

The selectmen will need to ask Marie St. Onge for the minutes from the town meeting.

The selectmen agreed to award the work for the upper Pond Road culvert to Frank Lucuis. Bruce Smith will contact Jonathan Sisson about the permitting for the other Pond Road culvert to be repaired at the same time.

Dave Lawrence discussed the need for a handicap access bathroom at the town hall. He will meet with Bruce Smith on Wednesday morning at 8:00 A.M.

John Davis stopped in looking for any information on the Patnode subdivision from Graz Engineering.

The selectmen discussed having Durwin Clark repair the culvert on the Joslin Rd. when it is convenient.

Jay Croteau met with a contractor about the carriage shed and what could be done within a set budget.

Bruce Smith had taken a tour of the roads and thought they were not in as bad a shape as discussed at town meeting. The selectmen discussed the potential project at the bottom of Joslin Road which is in bad shape.

There will be no safety meeting on Thursday night.

Bruce Smith will fill out the government census on line.

The selectmen signed the list of new appointees.

Bob Bergevin is interested in the cemetery trustee position.

Eric Eichner motioned to adjourn. Jay Croteau seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.
