## MEETING MINUTES MARCH 6,2017

The selectmen researched the towns policy for rental assistance for a local resident. The policy states the town would contribute 30% of the rent for one month. Bruce Smith will write a letter to the resident.

Eric Eichner has not heard back about the retention ponds from Barbara Patnode. Jay Croteau has emailed Erica Payne about the retention ponds as well as the as built plans if they are available for the Patnode subdivision.

The selectmen signed the payroll.

Jay Croteau motioned to accept the minutes. Bruce Smith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes as presented.

Bruce Smith reported Diluzio has projected to be able to handle the ambulance calls for Surry by June 1, 2017 with the purchase of an additional ambulance.

The selectmen discussed the ambulance contracts from City of Keene and Diluzio. Bruce Smith stated if the town choose Diluzio it could potentially save \$45,000.00 over the course of the three year contract. Jay Croteau stated he felt comfortable with signing with City of Keene because of their excellent service to the town in the past. Eric Eichner agreed with Jay Croteau to sign the contract with the City of Keene. The selectmen agreed to sign the contract with the City of Keene.

The Town of Surry received a credit for the gas remaining in the gas tanks removed from the Fire Station.

Bruce Smith is researching the abatement request for a hardship case.

Bruce Smith presented a written history of the cemetery trusts and the spreadsheet f or the trust funds in preparation for voting on Tuesday.

Jill Lane informed the selectmen about a 941 notice from the IRS which is being corrected.

Bruce Smith motioned to adjourn. Eric Eichner seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.
