SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES APRIL 30, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Bruce Smith and Eric Eichner.

The selectmen signed the payroll.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The Intent to Cut information from Wayne Young was put in the Conservation box for John Davis.

The Town of Surry received \$32.20 from DA Brothers for a building permit for Sue and Steve Kessler.

FEMA has awarded back to the Town of Surry \$9,254.15 due to the incorrect closeout of the Pond Road projects as a large project instead of separate small projects.

Bruce Smith spoke with a resident about a payment plan for his taxes. Bruce Smith will contact LGC about handling the accrual of the tax interest.

Bruce Smith met with DES on Wednesday to discuss the lower section of the Pond Road. They discussed the benefit cost analysis for the grant application and the site plan from the engineer. DES would ideally like to have something comparable to Graz's original proposal but were very supportive about moving forward. Bruce Smith sent a copy of the Army Corp of Engineers extended permit to Erin.

The selectmen will pursue gathering the data for doing nothing with the road. Bruce Smith will get an estimate from Dave Brooks. There may be a need for a dredge and fill permit.

Bruce Smith motioned to accept the minutes. Eric Eichner seconded the motion. The selectmen accepted the minutes.

Bruce Smith and Durwin Clark walked the culverts on the Pond Road and made sketches and measurements. Jay Croteau will photo document the culverts with arrows painted on them as well as the two new culverts proposed. Jonathan Sisson has agreed to do the permitting for the culverts.

The selectmen looked at the two bids for paving and would like to pursue an additional bid.

Jodi Leach will meet with Jay Croteau about repairing the shed. Durwin Clark will pull the stumps out.

The selectmen will speak with the town clerk about the submission of their fees.

The Planning Board did not have enough members for a quorum on Wednesday night.

Eric Eichner motioned to adjourn. Bruce Smith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
