SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES FEBRUARY 18, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Bruce Smith and Eric Eichner.

The Town of Surry received ck# 4673 in the amount of \$256.70 from Ketola Contracting LLC for a building permit for a two story home on Lot 5B 72 . The selectmen will review the driveway application and supply a street address.

Bart Cushing met with the selectmen about drilling a well on the Highway Department site. After reviewing the site, he felt he could safely drill on thenorth side of the building close to the boundary line in close proximity to the electrical already established on the building. He commented he has been successful with using cemented casing for protective wells at several sites locally and responded the average well depth was around 400 ft. He estimated the cost of digging, casing and well pump at \$10,000. He also suggested some corrective measures to be taken on the site for ground contaminants and salt runoff below the suggested drill site.

The selectmen signed the abatement for Caitlin and Jeremy Ward.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen signed the check deposit for the State of NH DOS- DMV.

The selectmen signed the letter to the Bethel Bible Church for tax exemption.

John Davis spoke with the selectmen about his deed.

Eric Eichner motioned to accept the minutes. Jay Croteau seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes.

Gretchen and Peter Morin notified the selectmen the voicemail for Avitar appointments was full. Bruce Smith left a message on Morin's machine.

Walley Reney has submitted his auditor's report.

Carol Lothrop dropped off school budget , articles and conservation reports.

Worked on the Comparative 2018.
