MEETING MINUTES MARCH 18, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Eric Eichner and Jamison Hines.

The selectmen reviewed the open positions in preparation for MS 232.

The selectmen read the state bridge report.

The selectmen signed payroll.

Avitar denied the abatement for Jeremy Ward for lot 5B 74 A. Jay Croteau will write a letter to them to be signed next week.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen discussed entertaining bids for the plowing and sanding of the Dort and Webster Roads.

The selectmen read the letter from Laura Ylitalo and viewed the photos of the Farm Road. Durwin Clark had repaired the washout at the culvert at the turn off over the weekend. Jay Croteau will contact Durwin Clark about the ditches and the gravel needed.

The Town of Surry received a PA 28 from the Casagrande Trust.

Robbo Holleran supplied the supplemental lot list for the Smith Forest plan.

Henry Underwood from SWCS spoke with the selectmen about the road surface inventory of town owned and maintained roads as part of the RSMS transportation project. The project would include assessing and documenting the pavement condition of individual roads and would prioritizing roads maintenance. A kickoff meeting will take place at the town hall March 25, 2019 at 8:00 P.M. A letter of interest will need to be submitted. The bills for the planning board books was submitted.

Additional gravel was applied and raked on the Mine Edge Road.

Jay Croteau motioned to adjourn. Eric Eichner seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.
