MEETING MINUTES JULY 15, 2019

The Town of Surry received a quotation from Jackson of \$14,000.00 to install the old heater in the town garage.

The selectmen discussed the foreclosure process for a resident and will ask Carolyn Berglund about the back taxes.

The selectmen will not be using the PA 28 Inventory of Property form . Jay Croteau emailed a signed copy in reply.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen signed payroll.

Jamison Hines drafted a rough draft of letter for Bear Den.

Durwin Clark graded the sides of Joslin Rd. He will pursue an additional quote for the heater installation from Bob's Fuel.

The town has not received a quote for painting the steeple.

The selectmen have authorized Phil's tree service to remove some trees on the Old Walpole Rd.

The information for the Thompson Brook reclamation was given to the Conservation Committee.

Durwin Clark was advised to mow the retention field on Cider Mill Rd when he mows the sides of the road in August.

The selectmen have authorized Durwin Clark to prepare to repair the culvert on the end of the Farm Rd.

John Berglund picked up the checks to be signed and the state deposit.

Jay Croteau motioned to adjourn. Eric Eichner seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.
