SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES JULY 29, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Eric Eichner and Jamison Hines.

The selectmen met for one hour because it was a fifth Monday in July.

The selectmen signed the payroll.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

A resident spoke with the selectmen about obtaining an elderly exemption as well as a veteran's exemption for his taxes. Jay Croteau supplied him with the proper documentation.

John Davis dropped off an Intent to Cut for JC Russell and cut by Tim Bievenu.

John Davis informed the selectmen the work on the Thompson Brook would begin next week. He also spoke with the selectmen about the current plan for the lower Pond Rd culvert from Right Angle Engineering and the current low water status of the brook. They also discussed the trees that needed to be cut on the Old Walpole Road and the stewardship of Wright's grove. He will be following up with the forester for Matheson.
