The selectmen will pursue hotel lodging for one week while Southwest Community service works on housing. Jay Croteau worked on temporary lodging for the resident.

Dave Bergeron spoke with the selectmen about subdivision on the Wilber requiring a variance from the Zoning Board. He was directed to attend the upcoming Planning Board meeting to begin his process.

The selectmen signed the MS-1 in preparation for setting the tax rate.

Jamison Hines will ask Durwin Clark to call Ciaredelli for the installation of the heater and tank. Wixon has not started the inside work.

Eric Eichner spoke with Mike Yarosevich and suggested he contact the Planning Board for his proposed subdivision.

The selectmen signed the letter to the trustee of trust funds for 2019 trust fund appropriations.

The selectmen worked on the building permit for Alotek for 56 Wilber Rd.

Jay Croteau motioned to adjourn. Eric Eichner seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.
