SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES DECEMBER 9, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Eric Eichner and Jamison Hines.

Jay Croteau worked with a resident for an elderly exemption.

Mark McKenzie spoke with the selectmen about subdividing his property and the existing cell tower. He asked about a lot line adjustment for the subdivision. The selectmen told him the tax bill goes to the owner of the property. He questioned the higher value to Verizon for taxation than for his value. Jay Croteau will contact Avitar regarding the assessment and his options.

Steve Goldsmith spoke with the selectmen about the intrusiveness of Avitar, the increase in the current bill, the excavator on Cider Mill Road and the brush along the state portion of the Old Walpole Road. He also submitted his bill for building inspector.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen signed the State of NH DMV – DOS payment.

The selectmen signed payroll.

The selectmen discussed the letter from Walter Krusinski regarding his trailer registered in Massachusetts but located at the campground. He claims because it is mobile he is exempt for the property taxes on it. The selectmen will research and get back to him.

The selectmen spoke about the safety deposit box and its contents. They have decided to empty the contents of the box and discontinuing the service. Jamison Hines will pursue.

The Town of Surry received a budget request from Home Health Care.

The insulation is almost completed at the Highway garage and the heat is working.

Eric Eichner motioned to accept the minutes. Jamison Hines seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes.

The selectmen discussed the balances in the trust funds.

The selectmen discussed items for the Highway budget for next year.

Jay Croteau motioned to adjourn. Eric Eichner seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
