MEETING MINUTES SEPTEMBER 16, 2019

Patrick Hinchly from the Nature Conservancy spoke with the selectmen about the purchase option on the 1300 acre Casagrande lot on Surry Mountain and including the portion of the land in Gilsum. The Nature Conservancy requested a letter of support signed by Jay Croteau from the Town of Surry earlier in the week to meet the Friday deadline for a grant application. The 3.5 million dollar project would be submitted under multiple use management and active forest management. The option of purchase has a deadline of December 31, 2019 with active pursuit of grant money. For interested parties, there will be a hike on October 5, 2019 at the trailhead on the Old Gilsum Rd.

Peter Morin spoke with the selectmen about putting a block foundation under his existing outbuilding and asked if a building permit was required .The foundation repair does not need a building permit.

Jamison Hines estimated the trailer hitch for the dump truck would be about \$1700.00. He will have Durwin Clark pursue a quote for the hitch.

The selectmen signed payroll.

Jamison Hines will proceed researching the refurbishing of engine #2 with a possible quote.

Jay Croteau motioned to accept the minutes. Eric Eichner seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes as presented.

The selectmen signed the State of NH DMV deposit for 9/12/2019 and 9/16/2019.

The MS-1 was approved by the DRA in preparation for the setting the tax rate. The DRA is still waiting for the school boards portion.

The Planning Board will be meeting the fourth Wednesday of the month at 7:00 P.M.

The selectmen signed for the inventory of radios to be reprogrammed with three additional radios from Jay Croteau.

Jill Lane and Bruce Smith will meet with Lisa Mudge from the state department about assessing next Monday morning.
