



Article 01 Choose Officers

To choose all necessary Town officers as listed on the official ballot.

Article 02 Consider changes to road ordinance.

Are you in favor of the following change to the Road Ordinance:

Add Farm Road, Cider Mill Road, and Mason Drive to the schedule of Street Classifications and Types and add the phrase "& State" to Old Walpole Road under Type,

Replace the phrase "Road Agent" with "Selectmen" throughout the ordinance, Add the phrase "and Ditches" to the heading of Article VI, Change the phrase "catch basins" to "catch basins and or culverts" in Article VI b, Change the phrase "corrugated aluminum pipe" to "corrugated plastic or aluminum pipe" in Article VI e,

Change the phrase "State of New Hampshire Highway Specifications" to "State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation Specifications" throughout the ordinance,

Change the phrase "these regulations" to "this ordinance" in Article XVII.

The purpose of these changes is to bring the Surry NH Road Standards Ordinance into compliance with current practice.

Article 03 Hear reports

To hear the reports of the Town Officers and Committees.

Article 04 Consider Town Operating Budget

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the budget committee recommended sum of \$489,148 for general municipal operations. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. The Budget Committee recommends this appropriation and the Selectmen tied in recommending this appropriation. (Majority vote required).

Article 05 Fund Hwy Equip CRF



To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$20,000 to place into the existing Highway Equipment Capital Reserve Fund for the future purchase of highway equipment. The Selectmen and the Budget Committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).

Article 06 Close 250th Anniv ETF

To see if the town will vote to discontinue the 250th Anniversary Expendable Trust Fund created in 2014. Said funds, \$6 with accumulated interest to date of withdrawal, are to be transferred to the municipality's general fund. The Selectmen and the Budget Committee recommend this article. (Majority vote required).

Article 07 Fund Fire Truck CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$40,000 to place into the existing Fire Truck Capital Reserve Fund for the purchase of a future fire truck. The Selectmen and the Budget Committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).

Article 08 Fire Equip CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$21,000 for the purchase of fire equipment, with \$14,000 from the existing Fire Equipment Capital Reserve Fund and \$7,000 from taxation. The Selectmen and the Budget Committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).

Article 09 Fund Prop Reval CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,000 to place into the existing Property Revaluation Capital Reserve Fund to pay for a future town wide property revaluation. The Selectmen and the Budget Committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).

Article 10 Cemetery Lot Sale Proceeds

To see if the town will vote to clarify Article 11 approved on March 12, 2015. As per provisions



of RSA 31:19-a, upon the sale of Cemetery Lots, 75% of the sale of lot money (sale of earth money) be deposited with the Trustees of the Trust Funds into a Cemetery Care expendable trust for maintenance of cemeteries and 25% of funds received shall be deposited in the general fund. The Cemetery Care expendable trust shall be used at the request of the Cemetery Trustees and approved by the Selectmen.

And further vote that the Cemetery Care expendable trust include all funds received from sale of lots since 2007.

Article 11 Any Other Business

To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
