MEETING MINUTES NOVEMBER 8, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau and Bruce Smith. Jamison Hines was absent.

The Town of Surry received \$11,294.69 from the county ARPA.

The Selectmen, Planning board and Conservation Committee will meet together to tour the gravel pit with the new owner at 9:00 A.M. Saturday November 13, 2021.

The selectmen discussed the town's tax rate on the DRA website with comparison other towns.

Jay Croteau will contact Bank of America about discontinuing the safety deposit box.

Jay Croteau spoke with Walley Reney about transference of duties to the new auditor.

The selectmen signed payroll.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

Bruce Smith reported on the meeting with the town clerk about the cemetery lots.

The selectmen spent quite some time discussing the equalization for the town. Average sale price for the town was \$321,000 with not enough sales to do an adequate analysis. The selectmen signed the 2021 Equalization Municipal Assessment Data Certificate.

Bruce Smith worked on the Wright transactions for the tax collector.
