SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES APRIL 11, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Present were Jay Croteau and Bruce Smith. Steve Goldsmith was absent.

Jay Croteau worked on Intents to Cut. Received Report of Wood Cut from Robbo Hollerin for Smith lot.

Received tax collectors notice for taxes 2022.

Avitar is completing field work for tax cards. Avitar will notify the town for data entry.

Bethel Bible Church exemption incomplete.

Josh Brooks has requested the town purchase a digital speed sign for use on Rt 12A and the Old Walpole with grant funding to control speeding in those areas. The selectmen declined the purchase of the speed sign.

The Fire Department has received the new generator.

The selectmen read the email regarding Broadband in New Hampshire.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

Bruce Smith will work on DES approvals for culverts with Durwin Clark and which culverts to take action on.

Jay Croteau moved to accept the paving bid from Allstate. Bruce Smith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the Allstate Bid. Jay Croteau will contact and ask to wait for drier weather this summer.

The selectmen discussed assigning Steve Goldsmith the steeple project.

The Cemetery trustees will meet with the selectmen and Durwin Clark Wednesday evening at 7:00 P.M.
