Now we are 532k under statewide average now. Total property valuation in 2020, got back to where we were when 2008 recession hit – our value is now the same. Tax rate dropped 50 cents; Surry went from 38th highest to 26th highest. There are only 31 towns in the state smaller than us, all around the same ranking
