SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES – MARCH 18, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Steve Goldsmith and Ron Profizer.

Katie Anderson and Griffin Kiritsy were referred to the Planning Board for a subdivision for Lot 5A- 97 on Mine Ledge road as a nonconforming lot. Would need to apply to ZBA for a variance .

Bill Fosher issued a complaint about gravel pit owner Jason Anyan burying demolition debris/ broken concrete with rebar over embankment. Stockpile of debris permitted but not burial. Produced video from his yard as evidence. Fill on top brought in on 3/18/2024 per Bill Fosher.

Jason Anyan brought in copy of bond for gravel pit from Frank Massin Insurance Fitwilliam NH. . Intent to Excavate with \$100.00 sent to State of New Hampshire. Also sent report of Excavated Material to State of New Hampshire for 2023. The selectmen spoke to him about the material brought in. He stated the concrete and asphalt was grinding for reuse and the concrete with rebar is being stockpiled for hiring a large crusher in the future. He stated he was putting dirt over it to prevent his loader tires from being punctured as he put it over the embankment. Prior drafted letter was not sent. Discussed reclamation plans. Steve Goldsmith spoke to him about not conforming to the building permit at his house.

John Davis discussed 2023 Timber tax . Went over Intents to cut and reports of cut with Jay Croteau.

John Davis suggested talking with Gary Kinyon for legal opinion for clarification of definition for retention ponds. He also suggested talking with Laura Barrett from the Planning Board.

MS 535 signed. Prepared to upload to portal .

MS 232 signed. Prepared to upload to portal.

The selectmen signed and paid bills .

The selectmen signed payroll. There was a question about 3 hours listed on Sunday.

Bruce Barry denied request to haul timber from Larocca's on Joslin Rd. Road is still posted.

Steve Goldsmith reported two more spots on Farm Rd. needs attention.

Steve Goldsmith would like post a new sign on the Farm Road Dead End and No Turn Around.

John Davis went over 2023 Timber Intents and Reports with Jay Croteau. He is willing to help with timber related issues.

Jay Croteau motioned to accept the minutes. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes as presented.

Bob Bergevin will email a building permit application for a20 x40 ft pole barn.

Solar exemption discussion for heating and cooling.

Steve Goldsmith motioned to adjourn. Jay Croteau seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.
