MEETING MINUTES AUGUST 19, 2024

Homeowner Kristen Avery spoke with the selectmen regarding the evulsion from the rechanneled Ashuelot river behind her house which is undermining her property jeopardizing her septic system. She has had prior contact with DES in 2014 without success. Realtor Michelle Wright accompanied her and submitted photographic evidence of the erosion, and has requested the Town of Surry facilitate an assessment of the Ashuelot River from New Hampshire's Fluvial Geomorphologist for recommendations.
