MEETING MINUTES MAY 15, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Bruce Smith and Steve Goldsmith.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen signed payroll.

Frank Conroy spoke with the selectmen about the quality of the gravel used on the Farm Rd as large and sharp enough to puncture his tires. The selectmen will speak to Durwin Clark about the gravel. Steve Goldsmith suggested the town use a heavy roller to smooth out the surface and will contact Frank Lucuis about using his roller.

Bill Bigelow requested a copy of his tax map and property card.

Steve Goldsmith has been working with Dickie Davis about filing a site plan for his building.

The Town of Surry has received two bids for paving the Old Walpole Rd. The bidders will be contacted to adjust the distance pave to meet the \$100,000.00 budget. Discussed increasing the amount raised for next years warrant.
