MEETING MINUTES JULY 24, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Bruce Smith and Steve Goldsmith..

Steve Goldsmith will deliver the LUCT for Ray Phillip for what he is taking out of current use.

Steve Goldsmith returned signed Current Use application for Art Johnson.

Jay Croteau and Bruce Smith worked on Intents to Cut for Russo and Raitto. Emailed to the state. Copy of Intent to Cut for Raitto was sent from state to him.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen signed payroll.

Durwin Clark will be working on the Old Walpole Road this week.

The selectmen signed the paperwork Joe Lucuis brought for the logging work done on his property.

The Town of Surry received ck#3400 in the amount of \$150.20 from Mike Edwards for building permit #1161 for 1139 Rt 12A.

Tim Bienvenu submitted Intent To Cut for Yasarovich 5/7/2023.

Josh Brooks, Tim Bienvenu, Jason Contrady and John Berglund from the Fire Department spoke with the selectmen about the approved \$50000 AFG grant for the Jaws of Life and hydraulic equipment with a 5% town match (\$2500) to be taken from Capital Reserve for Equipment. The Fire Chiefs also spoke about the pending approval for an AFG for a Brush Truck of \$325,000 with the \$16,000 match to be taken from the Fire Truck Capitol Reserve.

Steve Goldsmith motioned to accept the AFG to move forward with the submittal for the AFG grant for Jaws of Life and hydraulic Equipment. Jay Croteau seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to the submittal of the AFG Grant.

There was additional discussion regarding the close out of the last grant and three remaining invoices. There will need to be a Public hearing from the acceptance of the unanticipated funds.

Beth Leinau requested the use of the townhall for a play and would be selling tickets to help cover the copyright fee. The selectmen agreed to the use.

Jay Croteau motioned to accept the minutes. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes.

The selectmen will discuss assessing proposals next week.
