Building

- 1. Paint the porch and interior of the Town Hall.
- 2. Design and purchase a new Town Hall sign for the exterior.
- 3. Test the drinking water at the Town Hall.

Road Work

- 1. Pave the next section of Old Walpole.
- 2. Culvert review, prioritization, and clean-out schedule.
- 3. Purchase a front-end loader.
- 4. Select and purchase a radar speed sign.
- 5. 2026 paving plans.

Administration

- 1. Transition the Select Board's meeting from an office hours format to a more traditional town board meeting format.
- Establish more communication and coordination between all Town Boards.
- 3. Ensure compliance with CDL federal and state requirements.
- 4. Find ways to work more closely with the DPW in identifying needs and setting goals.
- 5. Review the current process for approving all applications and permits to determine their effectiveness from both the applicant and approval perspective.
- 6. Increase awareness of when permits are required.
- 7. Review and modify the town's application and permitting fees as necessary.
- 8. Develop prompt and consistent enforcement actions regarding zoning, ordinances, and regulations when violations are identified.
- 9. Increase involvement in the mechanics of tax rate setting on the NHDR portal
- 10. Work with the Budget Committee to improve the budgeting/budget review process.
- 11. Work with the Town Auditor to determine if and how the Select Board could assist in scheduling and securing timely access to the required reports and data.
