SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 20, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Steve Goldsmith and Ron Profaizer. Stev Goldsmith was late.

Durwin Clark submitted quotations for paving. The selectmen will discuss with him on meeting next Monday 27th. Farm Road broken into three sections for budgeting.

Permit approved and delivered to resident.

Ron Profaizer spoke with the Planning Board about AirBNB designations being added to the zoning ordinances. No response to AirBNB email. Planning board is working on legal changes for this session.

Jay Croteau called Cargill for a salt quote. Mortons quote signed for \$85.30 per ton . Check in July/ August of 2026 for next years quote. Jay Croteau will email signed agreement.

Current use application for 105 Farm Rd. Notify Avitar for 2 acre removal.

Ron Profaizer had Durwin Clark remove the radar sign across from Bob Bergevin on the Dam Rd. Data pulled average speed was 29 mph with 85% of cars with traffic of 655 cars over 5 days. Lock was added to sign.

Dot meeting for Bridge over Thompson Brook confirmed for Nov. 3, 2025 at 7:00 P.M.

RonProfaizer responded to Hillary Maye 603 Rt 12 A plot request.

Justin Ciazza received Ground water mapping as requested.

Ron Profaizer responded to tax question for 157 Farm Rd.

Ron Profaizer reviewed 211 Survey with nothing obvious to change.

Amer electric bid for townhall added to budget folder.

Katie Anderson call to septic designer stated current septic does not meet standard and not sized appropriately with recommendation for separate systems for both houses. No approval for second apartment.

No application for cottage industry. Ron Profaizer will draft welcome letter for new business with request for information. Ron Profaizer would like new businesses to be brought to the selectboards attention.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen signed payroll. DC log added to envelope.

Drummond and Woodsum bill to John Berglund for copies.

Ron Profzizer motioned to accept the minutes. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes.

Durwin Clark will order salt next week after processing the paper work.

The selectmen signed the tax warrant. Rate of \$16.82. Signed warrant to Carolyn Berglund.

Ron Profaizer will report pole #183 to Eversource for base repair.

Steve Goldsmith suggested sending a letter to Eversource to trim trees on the Old Walpole Rd to the town line. Commented on the state portion as unmaintained.

Building permit submitted for 12 x 28 shed for Parentequ. The Town of Surry received ck # 1572 for \$25.00.

Ron Profaizer submitted Bellemore quote for cleaning the culver on the Old Walpole road that is plegged. \$275 per hour for minimum of 4 hours with an additional man for \$175 per hour with second truck. The culvert may need to be replaced. Steve Goldsmith offered to get a second quote and suggested cleaning with cleaning with a firehouse. Durwin Clark cleaned half of the culvert with the fire house but was unable to thoroughly clean it. Tabled until next week.

Durwin Clark will be requested to backfill around the header for safety.

Community Kitchen request for \$1210.00 and Home Healthcare for \$2500 added to budget folder.

Reviewed Primex Property Liability Renewal summary.

Ron Profzier will arrange a meeting with Dave Burnstsein from Cheshire County. Tentative date November 17, 2025.

Denise Dragon was sent a raffle application.

Ron Profaizer sent warrant article draft to selectboard members as well as Laura Barrett regarding state compliance.

Ron Profaizer submitted building fee schedule for payment of services using state standards.
