

SURRY SCHOOL BOARD POLICY

EEA: Student Transportation Services

The Surry School District will acquire and provide transportation services for resident students consistent with applicable law and/or applicable contracts with other school districts or transportation providers. The School Board may establish contracts with transportation providers for regular student transportation services.

The Surry School Board does not operate any schools and is recognized as a sending district. Therefore, the Surry School Board recognizes and incorporates by reference student transportation policies and procedures applicable to students and parents/guardians of students attending the receiving school district and adopted by the receiving school boards in the school districts where Surry resident students attend school. This includes student transportation operating procedures, student conduct on school buses, and resolution of conflicts. Surry families and students are advised to make themselves aware of, and are required to comply with, the rules and regulations of the receiving school and the policies and practices of the receiving school board.

Surry resident students attending Surry Village Charter School may receive transportation from the District, on the same terms and conditions as students attending the receiving schools, utilizing the same regular bus schedules and routes that are utilized for the receiving students, and subject to the same bus conduct standards that apply to Surry students attending the receiving schools. Surry residents who wish to utilize district transportation should contact the Surry Superintendent.
