SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES MARCH 30, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau and Ron Profaizer. Steve Goldsmith was absent.

The selectmen signed and paid bills

The selectmen signed payroll.

Jay Croteau motioned to accept the minutes. Time for ZBA meeting added. Ron Profaizer seconded the motion. The selectmen accepted the minutes.

Received Report of Cut from Tim Bienvenu 5A lot 90 25-437-09.

Still waiting on HMGP 4799 .

Roe 15 inch driveway culvert not confirmed.

Jay Croteau emailed Bethel Bible Church to schedule a discussion. Bruce Smith commented about potential access for cemetery.

Bid review for paving projects scheduled for April 20th, 2026 beginning at 6:00.

Selectmen's document manual in progress. Waiting for ordinances to be updated.

Motion detector porch lights have not been installed yet.

Jason Anyan dropped off Intent to Excavate 26-437-01. Submitted copy of Bond.

Bart Cushing came in per request of the selectboard regarding the excavation site on his property. After discussion, the selectmen referred him to the Planning Board for Permit to Excavate with new site plan before pursuing a building permit. Reference to Site Plan Regulations.

Walter and Kerry Baker requested information to build a home on 5B-78-02. The LUCT has not been computed yet from Avitar. They were referred to the website for a driveway application and were instructed to contact the state for a curb cut on the Old Walpole Rd.

The selectboard asked Bruce Smith to complete the Dwelling unit Survey for 2025.

Jay Croteau will ask Zane White about his gravel operation again.

Discussion of contacting state gravel appraiser.

Discussion of personal care mileage reimbursement at 72.5 cents per mile for employees.
Addition of trash pickup and pot hole repairs for Durwin Clark to do. As well as trees on Pond Rd and culvert inspections especially those that could be blown out with the fire hose.

Conservation Committee is willing to organize townwide roadside trash pickup for Earth Day April 25 and 26 2026. No decision on where to deposit trash collected. Options included town truck at the Fire Station with open tailgate or possibly the dumpster at the Highway Department.

Cushing Report of Excavation submitted.

March 31, 2026 last day for abatements to be submitted.

Excavation notices due April 1, 2026.

The selectmen passed on discussing NHPDIP.

The library was interested in coordinating with the selectmen on a cleaning person. The selectmen discussed rate and hours for cleaning. The selectmen decided to have the applicants come in next week at 7:00 P.M.

Ron Profaizer completed the 211 NH update.

The selectmen signed the letter to Larocca requesting a PA33 for transfer the solar exemption.

The Town of Surry received the Arcadia Royalty for History Books sold.
