SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES APRIL 20, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 and 6:30 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Steve Goldsmith and Ron Profaizer.

The selectmen went over bids for Farm Road with the contractors with discussion on more specifics for Farm Road work. Items discussed were fabric, depth of gravel , purchase of culverts by town or supplied, hammering the ledge added or included in bid, crowning of road, working ditch lines, estimation of working hours and duration of project and approximate start dates.

Ron Profaizer discussed including Durwin Clark in the culvert decision making process. Ron Profaizer motioned to utilize Durwin Clark to do onsite inspections for driveway application recommendations for culvert size. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed.

The selectmen agreed the 12 inch culvert at Roe's was sufficient.

Garrett Nelson driveway was discussed as another place a culvert might be needed. Steve Goldsmith stated the driveway was engineered by a state engineer.

Discussion of culvert at 4C -82 A2 Kyle Bently. No decision.

Durwin Clark worked on filling gravel on roads.

The selectmen signed payroll.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

Jason Anyan spoke with the selectmen stating he has winter sand available for town purchase. He confirmed with the selectmen his Intent to Excavate was sent to the state. He discussed the quote for paving the town parking lot and Pond Road apron stating he would stand by the prices he originally quoted. He would be interested in doing additional work for the town.

Posted road signs will be removed this week.

Leslie Johnson spoke with the selectmen asking if she would need a building permit for some roofing repair work. The selectmen felt it was unnecessary for the type of repair. She also mentioned a pink boundary flag that had recently been put up on the corner of her lot. In addition, she mentioned a solar powered trail camera with a light had been put up on the London and Farm Road .The owner for the camera/light was unknown. She also inquired in the notes for the Tree Agent meeting would be available for the Conservation Committee before

the May meeting. Lastly,, she was would be happy to spread the word about the roadside cleanup on Saturday.

The selectmen moved into and non public executive session at 7:35 P.M.

The selectmen ended the non public executive session at 7:45. P.M.The Town of Surry received ck# 1033in the amount of \$168.88 from Tree Agents LLC for Planning Board notices.
