

## **SURRY SCHOOL BOARD POLICY**

### **Policy JICK: Pupil Safety and Violence Prevention – Bullying**

The Surry School Board does not operate any schools and is recognized as a sending district. The Surry School Board believes that schools should be safe places for children to learn and develop. Therefore, the Surry School Board recognizes and incorporates by reference the policies and procedures adopted by receiving school boards related to pupil safety and violence prevention, including the provisions of RSA 193-F.

Surry families and students are advised to make themselves aware of, and are required to comply with, the rules and regulations of the receiving school and the policies and practices of the receiving school board. As applicable, members of the community are expected to comply with the receiving board's policies, school handbooks and administrative procedures, subject to the limitations and exceptions set forth herein.

While overall school safety is the responsibility of the receiving school district, Surry residents may contact the Superintendent of the Surry School District or the Surry School Board to discuss concerns relative to pupil safety.
