

SURRY SCHOOL BOARD POLICY

Policy JJJ: Access to Public School Programs by Non-Public, Public Charter, and Home Educated Students

All pupils residing in the Surry School District, whether they are home educated, or are attending public charter school or nonpublic schools, but not home educated pupils who have graduated from a high school level program or its equivalent or has obtained the age of 22, (collectively, “non-enrolled district students”), shall have access to curricular courses and co/extra-curricular programs offered by the receiving school district in accordance with RSA 193:1-c and in accordance with receiving school district policy and administrative regulations.

The Surry School Board does not operate any schools and is recognized as a sending district. Therefore, the Surry School Board recognizes and incorporates by reference the policies and procedures applicable to students and parents/guardians of students attending the receiving school districts and adopted by the receiving school boards in the school districts where Surry resident students attend school. Non-enrolled students residing in the Surry School District are advised to refer to the policies and procedures of the receiving districts regarding access to public school programs by non-public students.
