SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES JUNE 1, 2026

The meeting was called to order Present were Jay Croteau, Steve Goldsmith and Ron Profaizer.

Jay Croteau motioned to accept the minutes. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen signed payroll.

The selectmen signed the EFTPS payment.

Confirmed required June meeting with Karyn Hagen for Supervisors of the Checklist for June 2, 2026 townhall.

Selectboard documents binder started.

Invoice correction for Horse and Buggy to Highway Dept. not Cemetery.

State of New Hampshire DOS DMV check for 5/21/2026 signed by selectmen .

Quickbooks EF payment entered by John Berglund for 5/1/2026 signed by selectmen.

Wayne Brown spoke with the selectmen about permission to cut trees on the border of the Conservation land and his Cider Mill Property citing they were dead. Steve Goldsmith has viewed the lot and commented about the 100ft buffer zone. He was referred to the Conservation Committee and the Conservation Trustee for permission.

David Keurulainen spoke with the selectmen requesting permission to cut the trees with the road right of way. He asked about the actual road width as well as receiving a driveway permit with intentions to move preexisting building to the lot as a residence.

Russ Fiorey requested to confirm his ROW across Goodwin property for a future logging operation. Goodwin deed confirms language for ROW for Fiorey. Provided copies and map. Map 1 lot 30 Goodwin Jr. 880 Rt 12 A. BK 3064 Pg 304

Ron Profaizer working on NHMA Legal Services user list and use policy.

Jay Croteau responded to Surry School Board email.

Ron Profaizer posted the Town Auditor position to the website and the town newsletter.

The selectmen agreed to have the Highway Dept take down the camera on the London Road and informed Nicole Conroy she could pick it up at the Highway shed.

Planning Board is working on Cushing and Son as commercial gravel excavation operation.

Planning Board is waiting for Zane White Excavation Permit.

Bethel Bible Church lot on hold.

The curb cut on the Mine Ledge Road is being monitored.

Avitar has not provided LUCT for Dorman yet.

Highway Dept worked on cleaning Cider Mill culvert and ditch as requested. Recommended to continue the ditch work further at site.

Performance reviews set for June.

Joslin Road closed for washout 5/26/2026. Gravel has been added and raked.

Joslin Road closed for tree down 5/30/2026. Tree was removed.

Policy for Acceptance carry over to next week.

The selectmen will research drainage issue on Walsh Cider Mill. Planning Board supplied original site plan for Cider Mill. Discussion of #4 DES /wetlands with no further changes noted. Drainage easement shown on the plan. The Conservation Committee request for information. Directive to Walsh to not plug or remove culvert.

Jay Croteau motioned after research and discovery of Cider Mill Plan information move to keep the culvert the way it is with no changes. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed.

NHMA in kind local match of \$3,062.39 from Emergency Management Jason Contrady. Ron Profaizer motioned to have chair Jay Croteau sign local match commitment letter and Technical Assistance agreement allowing SWRPC to execute the work. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed.

The selectboard research RSA 21:34 A for Village violation of Art 5 ZBA ordinance. Discussion of farm definition and ZBA land use requiring a special exception.

Steve Goldsmith inspected and passed Ken Cook's electrical upgrade.

Email response to Fontain stating the town would be doing a total revaluation in 2027.

The selectmen accepted the resignation of Sharon Sweeney as Trustee of Trust Funds.

Under Construction list to Steve Goldsmith.

Abatement for Jason and Christine Hammond to be submitted to Avitar.

Steve Goldsmith inspected the insulation and electrical for Walter Goodnow renovation.

Primex has returned \$330 to the Town Of Surry from public funds.
