SELECTMEN

MEETING MINUTES JUNE 8 2026

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Jay Croteau, Steve Goldsmith and Ron Profaizer.

The selectmen signed and paid bills.

The selectmen signed payroll.

Ron Profaizer motioned to accept the minutes. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to accept the minutes.

Jason Anyan expects to start the townhall parking lot mid July. Downpayment on project \$11,850.00 5/11/2026 ck # 23662.

Fred Lower spoke with the selectmen about receiving a tax bill for the 77 Hallwood Drive destroyed in a fire. Avitar will need to be contacted to correct the tax card and the tax collector will be notified to abate the bill.

The selectmen's ordinance documents are in process.

The camera was removed from the London Rd.

Cushing and Sons permit still in process with the Planning Board.

Zane White permit still in process with Planning Board.

Highway Comcast and Spectrum bills to be reviewed by selectboard. Copes for townhall, Fire station for phone and internet.

Bethel Bible Church land on hold.

Driveway cut on the Mine Ledge Road being monitored.

Luct for Dorman for July 1, 2026.

Bruce Smith informed the selectmen Keene Monument would be repairing stones in the Cemetery. The town will be reimbursed from the Cemetery Trust Funds for \$5000.00 after paying the bill from the general fund.

Lower Joslin Rd was discontinued March, 11, 1941 with the town clerk confirming the date with the town meeting minutes.

Bruce Smith examined the Merriam Farm road width in question at 2-3 rods wide with no physical evidence of a wider width.

Streeter Rd was discontinued March 2006 Art 17. Ron Profaizer responded to email noting it was passed in the town meeting minutes.

The School Board will meet next week and will adjust the school payment beginning in July.

Open assignment for Durwin Clark to clean culvert inlets on the town road.

The selectmen will review the policy for the Non Public Session for the manual RSA 91- A:3.

Jay Croteau motioned to accept the Non Public Session policy pursuant RSA91- A:3. Ron Profaizer seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed .

LHMP completed copy returned by Jason Contrady.

The selectmen reviewed letter from Municipal Association about zoning violation in the village. The selectboard are authorized to enforce. Jay Croteau will review zoning ordinance.

Nation Grid Power document request from 12/31/25. Pa 81 on 5/19/2026. Utility information in July.

Dorman driveway permit request to waiver the culvert. Completed without authorization from Selectboard. Ron Profaizer motioned to approve no culver at driveway with stipulation to direct water to existing road culverts. Steve Goldsmith seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed.

Discussion of RSA allowing residents to build on class VI roads pending July 1, 2026. Moved to next week.

The selectboard will view the trees on the Merriam Road Keurulian asked to cut and stated the gate should remain. The selectboard was clear about the 30 day limit for a camper on the property.

The Town of Surry received ck#639 in the amount of \$60.00 from Jason Crosby for electrical upgrade from Ken Cook.

Local match letter for file from Jason Contrady.

Intent to cut for Tim Bienvenu 5A 82 26-437-01 sent to state. Letter to him for next week.

Cushing 911 address to Bruce Smith Emergency Management. Driveway defines the process.

Nancy Callender offered to be town auditor if no one else volunteers by and of June.

Conservation Committee denied Wayne Brown to remove the trees on the town property. John Davis hand delivered the denial. Confirmed with the Monadnock Conservancy who manages the property.

Ron Profazer introduced information from NHMA on multiple membership on Land Use Boards and selectboards with emphasis on identifying people.

Update to Legal Services Policy adding the town treasurer.

Email from West Watershed study from Cheshire County Consultation forwarded to Conservation Committee.

No driveway permit for Baker yet. State permit required on state road. Tax Collector sent Luct of \$8000.00. No building permit in process.

Ron Profazier responded to C. Cody email Streeter Road discontinued.

Ron Profazier will contact Frank Lucuis for start date on Farm Road for newsletter.

Approximate project dates: Farm Rd this week June 10, 2026, July for townhall parking lot and mid July for Old Walpole Road.

For Highway Department holes filled on the lower Pond Road and ditching on Mine Ledge Road, also removed scrap metal from the town garage.

Incomplete tasks are tree removal on Joslin Road, brush removal of sight lines Joslin Road, tree on wire on the Surry Dam Road.

Ron Profazer will attend the June Planning Board meeting. He will be absent for both the July and August Planning Board meeting.

The speed sign will be moved to the record the downhill traffic on the Joslin Rd. Durwin Clark will be asked to move and install the pipe.

Steve Goldsmith contacted Frank Richter from Clean Energy about an energy audit for the Townhall and library. He recommended Clean Energy contact the school board directly.

Cinta will test the fire extinguishers for the Library, Townhall, Fire Station and Highway Department.

Jay Croteau motioned to adjourn. Ron Profazer seconded the motion. The selectmen agreed to adjourn.
